

Durham County ABC Board Conflict of Interest Review and Declaration

G.S. 18B-700(h) conflict of interest states that 18B-201 shall apply to all local boards. G.S. 18B-201(e) requires that the provisions of Chapter 138A of the General Statutes apply. The N.C. ABC Commission has developed the attached statement to be in compliance with the statute.

The following statement of the presiding officer shall be read at the opening of all meetings:
